

Lord Sainsbury opened the National Technicia Development Centre

The National Technician Development Centre for Higher Education, based at the Univ Sheffield, was officially opened by Lord Sainsbury on the 13th of February.

The National Centre was set up following an investment of £1.125 million, including £ from the Higher Education Funding Council for England (HEFCE) and funding from the University of Sheffield and other partners of more than £580,000.

Welcoming Lord Sainsbury at the ceremony were the President and Vice-Chancellor of University of Sheffield, Professor Sir Keith Burnett, and the Director of the National G Chairman of the Institute of Science and Technology (IST), Terry Croft.

IST Supporting Arts Technicians

We hope that you will agree with us that it is an exciting time for arts technicians, as currently the IST is working towards supporting their professional status in line with science technicians. We are aware that this particular group is not as well represented on a national level as their science colleagues, and the IST is keen to address this imbalance. Great work has been done to recognise the professionalism and skills of science tabead technicians, led by the Science Council and the distby Foundation with the introduction of the Science Council's registration scheme and the Gatsby Foundations 'Technicians Make It Happen' work, but feedback from colleagues in the arts suggests that the Science Council's registration scheme does not quite fit for those working in a creative arts and media background.



To this end the IST has formed a working groups of arts technicians and managers to develop their existing Registered Practitioners scheme so that it aligns with the needs and roles of arts technicians, and to provide a platform for them to be recognised for the excellent work that they do. This is a work in progress, and very early days, we have had one meeting with the working arcup and the

next is planned for March, but so far the signs are positive and we believe that there is good scope to make sure arts technicians are given the opportunity to demonstrate their value, contribution and professional status in their roles. Watch this space...


